#### Reports:

#### Ice Scheduler's Report – John:

- Time changes made for IP1,IP2 & Minor Novice on Sunday to help with the time to assemble boards for games
- Time changes made for Novice LL games to help with time to assemble boards practice before games will be reduced to a 40 minutes on ice practice
- Haldimand County held a meeting on October 29 to discuss allocation formula in ice booking policy for all user groups - waiting for details from County
- Practice schedule for the first week of January will be updated in mid December
- Practice Schedules will not be updated further out until League Playoff schedules are completed for LL & Rep/AE - basically scheduling until the end of the year will be on a week by week basis

#### **VP of Rep/AE Report – Beth:**

- Crunch is on to get games finished by the end of the year, there were a few cancellations due to weather yesterday so we need to get them rescheduled asap
- Novice Rep The novice rep coach has some concerns that other centres are not really following the rules i.e. moving the half ice boards out further to give them more room and use both doors Beth mentioned this at the SC meeting but there did not seem to be any concern and no one is really policing it the only thing that was mentioned was using the big nets

 There are a few different configurations that can be utilized according to Hockey Canada so we may need to look at this moving forward

#### **VP of Local League Report – Shawn:**

- There are two sets of boards (half ice) one set actually belongs to Mark Annett these half ice boards need to be lined up when they are getting put together and also when they are being stored,
- We need to change the tires on the Minor Hockey cart as it is difficult to get the cart on and off the ice – Mark uses a pole to push it up and get it on/off the ice
- Still following up with the County regarding the mould on these
- Unless the arena is closed, there are no cancellations LL Rules #7 cancelling the game need 48 hours notice or else there is a \$250/fine unless it is inclement weather; needs to go through the convenor and not the Ice Scheduler or the VP of LL if this is the case, then the league convenors will need to have contact information for the other league convenors for instance Caledonia PeeWee convenor attempted to find the contact information for Hagersville PeeWee convenor but it is not on their website.
- If a game gets cancelled and there is ice available, can the home team practice? Traciann will follow up with the Ice Scheduler to see what happens with that?

- 11 kids out for Goalie development (there was 12 but one backed out); the parents of some of the kids have expressed that they would like to have more here for development – we will need to see what ice we have available and what volunteers; Mark will ask to see if there is more ice available to run some more goalie development – could we use the Wednesday development night for this?
- A few people have expressed concern about the development on Wednesday, it is mostly the helpers showing up and Mark will speak to Velonosi regarding this – the agreement is that he will be here 50% of the time;
- Had goalie pads donated by Pro Hockey Life Academy to outfit a goalie for the goalie development
- The current goalie development program is that CDMHA reimburses \$300 to the goalies if we
  move to change this then we may need to look at changing what we offer now
- Could be possible to look at when the County is running their parent and tot skate to coincide and utilize this
- Can the black dividers be used for other levels, the answer to this is yes, they belong to CDMHA
  and we will advise the coaches and county that they can be used.
- Can we condense the cages into one and use the other cage for the coaches to store stuff in –
  there would need to be some more discussion on this, we need to speak to Leanne about what
  is down there and what can be left in there

- For Development night on Monday, can we make sure that Velonosi and his crew are using the far dressing rooms leaving the girls dressing room closest to the doors open for any girls who might want to use them? Follow up with County regarding these rooms...
- The River Cats have asked permission to use the small nets for their minor novice and novice girls as they too have to conform to the half ice requirement. They have agreed to assist with any costs related to damage they have caused and for costs related to maintenance and upkeep of the small nets. The maintenance fees will be assessed on an annual basis. Letter of agreement to be made up between the two associations.
- There is a concern that moving to fall tryouts will be an issue we will need to check on ice and the feasibility of changing to the fall tryouts, we will bring this up with the Ice Scheduler
- Changing of the levels from Novice etc to U7, U10 etc.
- Team party confirmation that teams could utilize the reimbursement for their Christmas parties but that the money would not be reimbursed until the end of the year when all equipment was returned to CDMHA
