

## Appendix 6 - CDMHA Goalie Equipment Loan Agreement

## **CDMHA Goalie Equipment Loan Agreement**

It is understood that the below listed goalie equipment is the property of the CDMHA.

It is understood that it is the responsibility of the person signing out this goalie equipment to return all CDMHA goalie equipment to the Equipment Manager by whichever is the earliest date of April 1 of the current hockey season, or upon leaving CDMHA membership. If the CDMHA property is not returned to the CDMHA, the person signing for this equipment will be held financially responsible to replace the said CDMHA property.

During the regular season, CDMHA requires a deposit cheque of \$300.00, post-dated for April 1 of the current hockey season, from all individuals borrowing CDMHA goalie equipment.

(Note: For summer hockey usage, CDMHA requires a deposit cheque of \$300.00, post-dated for September 1 of the current year, from all individuals borrowing CDMHA goalie equipment.)

Should the equipment not be returned by the specified date, the deposit cheque will be cashed. You will be invoiced for the replacement cost of the goalie equipment, minus the \$300 deposit. Should the deposit cheque bounce, NSF charges will be added to invoice along with the \$300.00 deposit amount.

In the event of misuse of equipment, CDMHA reserves the right to recover equipment from the renter at any time.
