Tournament Rules and Regulations

Overview

The Mick Sabatine Memorial Jamboree is an **OMHA-sanctioned tournament**. All games will follow **OMHA rules and regulations**.

- Minimum Games: Each team is guaranteed at least 3 games
- **Eligibility**: All players must participate in at least one preliminary game to qualify for elimination, Semi-Final, or Championship play.

Age Divisions

U9 Division

- Round robin play within one division. This is only applicable if the tournament is full with 8 teams.
- Semi-Final and Championship rounds.
- Games: Three 10-minute stop-time periods.
- Overtime (playoffs only):
 - 5-minute sudden victory overtime (5-on-5).
 - o If still tied → shootout (see rules below).

Registration

- Participation is based on first to register and pay.
- Teams must provide an **approved OMHA roster** (or applicable roster) before their first scheduled game.
 - o Failure to provide will result in disqualification until submitted.
- Affiliated players must be included on the approved roster.
- Coaches/trainers from an "At Large Roster" must be documented.
- Only players on the official roster sheet may participate.

- o No additions after the first game.
- Absent, sick, injured, or suspended players They need to appear on all games sheets with a reason as to why they are not playing as per the electronic gamesheet requirements.
- Game sheets will be managed electronically via Gamesheet Inc.
- All teams must provide a valid Travel Permit.

Games

General Rules

- Teams must check in 1 hour before their first game.
- Be prepared to start up to 15 minutes early.
- "Home" teams are designated on the schedule.
- Jersey conflicts: The "Home" team must wear tournament-supplied jerseys, returned immediately after the game in good condition.

U9 Round Robin

- Three 10-minute stop-time periods.
- No overtime during round robin.
- Points:
 - o Win = 2 points
 - o Tie = 1 point
 - Loss = 0 Points
- **Defaults**: Non-offending team awarded a 3–0 win.

Mercy Rule:

- If a team leads by 5+ goals in the 3rd period → run time begins.
- If gap narrows to 3 goals → revert to stop time.
- Penalties under run time = 1.5x (e.g., 2 minutes = 3).

Tie-Breakers:

1. Head-to-head result.

- 2. Most wins.
- 3. Fewest goals against.
- 4. Fewest penalty minutes (minors = 2, majors = 5; misconducts not included).
- 5. Longest shutout streak to start the tournament.
- Coin toss.

Playoffs (U9 Quarter Final, Semi-Final & Championship)

- Games: Three 10-minute stop-time periods.
- Overtime Procedure:
 - 1. 5-minute sudden victory overtime (5-on-5).
 - 2. If tied → shootout (3 shooters per team). After the initial 3 shooters, the shootout should be sudden victory. Each team must designate the first three shooters on the game sheet prior to the start of the semi-final or final game. The "Home" team will shoot first. If a winner is not decided after the first 3 shooters, a sudden victory shootout will occur. Players cannot shoot again until all players have taken a shot. If additional shootout rounds are required, the shootout rotation will remain the same as the previous round. If a player is serving a penalty at the end of overtime, that player is not eligible to participate in the shootout.

Team Etiquette

- Dressing rooms must remain locked. Organizers are not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- Teams are liable for any facility damage. Report pre-existing damage immediately to
 officials.
- Music in dressing rooms is permitted if:
 - Volume is reasonable.
 - o Content is appropriate for all ages.
- No players or officials may enter referee rooms or timekeeper boxes.
- Respect for opponents, referees, officials, and volunteers is required.

- o **Zero tolerance** for verbal or physical abuse.
- o Misconduct from the stands may result in team expulsion.
- No cameras are permitted in change rooms.

Tournament Committee

- The Caledonia Minor Hockey Association, Tournament Committee, officials, and volunteers assume **no liability** for injury, damages, theft, or losses.
- The Committee reserves the right to make final decisions on:
 - Interpretation of tournament rules.
 - o Adjustments to round robin format.
 - o Tournament protests or objections.

All decisions are final.
